Will South Mimms Parish Council be merging with Ridge or / and Shenley Parishes?

The simple answer is, we don't know yet. Hertsmere Borough Council has been reviewing the arrangements for the electoral parish of Ridge, following the dissolution of their previous Parish Council, as part of a Community Governance Review that is also looking at arrangements for Aldenham Parish Council.

After an initial public consultation, Hertsmere put forward a proposal for the electoral parishes of South Mimms and Ridge to merge, with this combined Parish Council to be split into two wards, to ensure that there was always one Councillor representing Ridge with the other four representing South Mimms. The second public consultation has just closed, and we now await the outcome, which will be announced later this year.

Any new arrangements will take effect from next May, when Councillors will stand for election or re-election.

Maintenance Updates:

The Hertsmere owned garages are to be refurbished starting in September.

The public footpath and cycle path on **Swanland Road** will have the old broken motorway barrier removed, which will allow for the ride-on mowers to maintain the area properly, thanks to a £15,000 grant from Hertsmere Leader Cllr Morris Bright.

The **footpath from the church** gate to the pedestrian crossing on St Albans Road will be repaired and widened next month.

New South Mimms **village name signs** saying 'please drive carefully' should be in place by the end of the year at the three main entry points to the village.

<u>Planning Matters:</u> The **aggregates site on St Albans Road, next to Romani House** continues to blight the village, but the National Planning Inspectorate have delayed the Public Enquiry into the site until the end of 2022. This will be a full two years after Hertsmere refused planning permission for a change of use and three years since the Office of the Traffic Commissioner refused a retrospective application to operate HGVs from the site. SMPC continue to put whatever pressure we can on the operators via the Hertsmere Enforcement Team and Environmental Health.

Griggs Homes still haven't put in any planning applications for developing the old **White Hart** pub. However, we know the War Memorial triangle is safe now.

The current **Local Plan** for new housing in Hertsmere was 'set aside' earlier this year, whilst the Borough Council wait for revised housing requirement figures to come down from central government and Hertfordshire County Council. We now aren't expecting any news until 2023. Having `previously secured a significant reduction in the number of new houses due to be bult in South Mimms, SMPC are keeping a close eye on the situation and will update you in due course.
